Dear Parents:

As you know, we had to go to school virtually for our 7-12 grades this past week as well as cancel all extra-curricular activities for the week. This was necessary due to the large number of students that were quarantined in those grades. COVID-19 positives are on the rise, especially in rural Oklahoma. We have seen a sharp increase in COVID-19 positive cases in the communities of Chattanooga and Faxon recently.

Our number one priority at Chattanooga School is the safety and well-being of our students, staff, and their families. It is vitally important for all of us to follow the safety guidelines of wearing a mask, maintaining social distance, and washing hands frequently if we are going to continue to have in-person school, participate in FFA activities, or compete in athletic contests, etc.

We also need everyone to follow the quarantine guidelines set forth by the CDC. This includes staying at home for 14 days after your last contact with a person who has COVID-19, monitoring for symptoms, and staying away from others, especially people who are at a higher risk for complications from COVID-19. Please understand that we work in conjunction with the Comanche County Health Department on contact-tracing and quarantining students. We provide information; however, the Health Department makes the decision on who is quarantined.

With the recent spike of COVID-19 positive cases due to indoor activities, Chattanooga Schools will now begin to limit crowd size at basketball games. We are doing this to provide a safe environment for our students to participate. Each Chattanooga player will receive 4 tickets for each home game. The ticket holder will then be able to purchase a ticket at the door to attend the game. If you do not have a ticket, you will not be admitted.

Thank you for your cooperation in keeping our students safe.
