We need your help!

We have adopted guidelines for our basketball games for this season. These guidelines were put into place to protect everyone that attends one of our games.

Following are the guidelines that were adopted:

Masks are required to enter the gym and any time that you leave your seat
Please wear a mask while in your seat unless eating or drinking
Seating will only be allowed in every other row
No seating is available in the row directly behind team benches
Social distance when possible
No spirit lines
Fans are asked to leave the gym as soon as possible when game is over
Children should be accompanied by an adult and remain seated with the family throughout the games
Sit in family groups when possible
Wash and sanitize hands often
No pre or post-game handshakes

We have blocked off every other row of seating to help with social distancing. Unfortunately, this was not followed by some of our fans during our Tuesday game with Sterling. Mask wearing was also an issue on Tuesday night. Masks are **required** any time that you are out of your seat and **strongly recommended** while in your seat.

If we continue to have problems with adherence to our guidelines, we will be forced to limit attendance at our games. This is not a step that we want to take, but we are prepared to do so if necessary.

Our number one priority is to protect our students and to ensure that they get to participate in their activities this year. We must also protect each other. The positive COVID-19 cases are rapidly increasing across our state, and we must all do our part to take care of each other. It is our responsibility as adults to set a positive example for our kids.
